DOCUMENTED DIAGNOSIS OF PLAQUE PSORIASIS FOR OVER 6 MONTHS

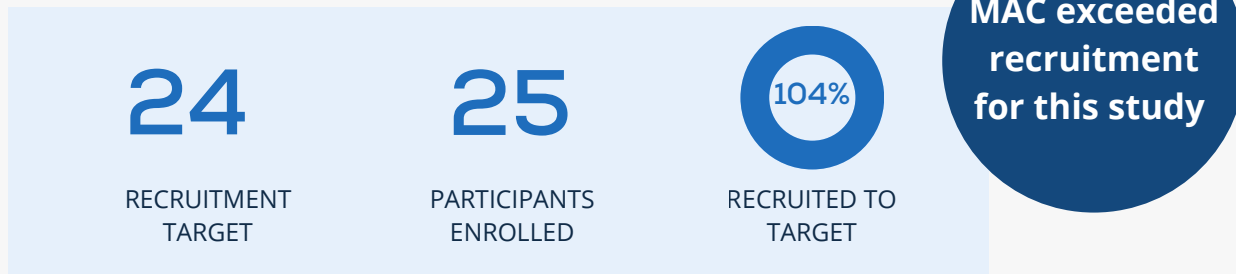

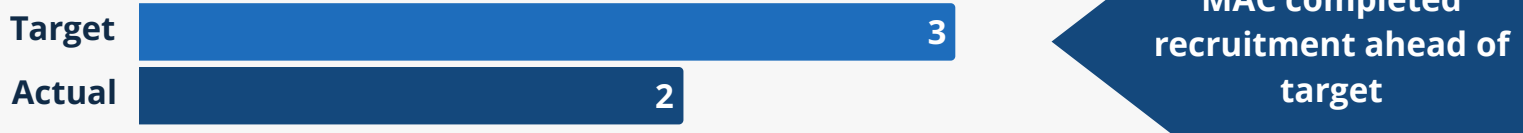
- PASI SCORE OF ≥ 6 AND ≤ 15

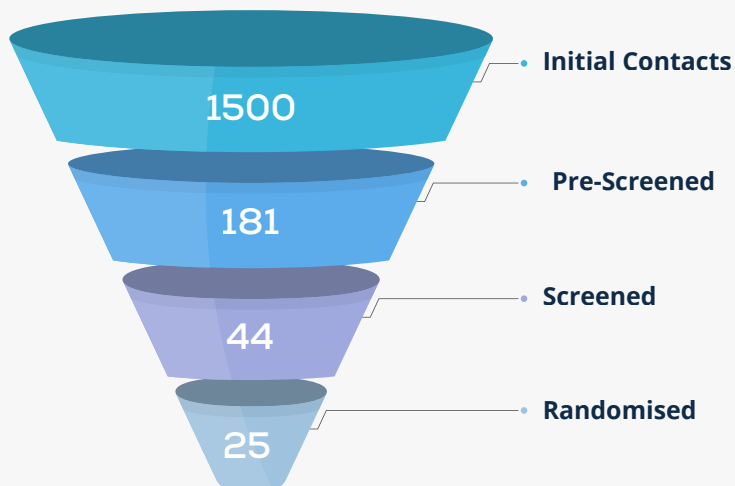
PARTICIPANT RECRUITMENT



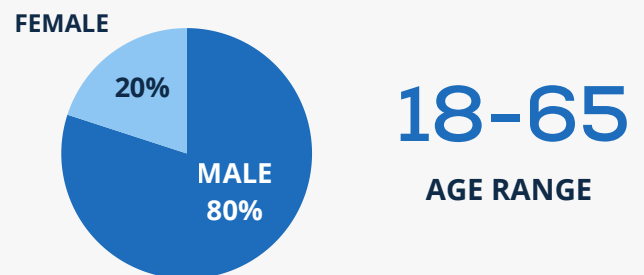
RECRUITMENT TO TARGET (NO. OF MONTHS)
